



MANAGER'S MESSAGE

When it comes to a home's irrigation system, a little maintenance goes a long way. Homes with clock timer-controlled irrigation systems use about 50 percent more water outdoors than homes without irrigation systems. Your system can waste even more if it's programmed incorrectly, a sprinkler head is pointed in the wrong direction, or you have a leak. Before you ramp up your watering efforts, spruce up your irrigation system by remembering four simple steps: inspect, connect, direct, and select.

Meridian Ranch Communication is Key DRC 1 & 2

Most, if not all, residents in Meridian Ranch have received a covenant violation during their time living in the community. These notices are sent as an educational communication as residents are not always aware that something on their Lot is out of compliance. The "period to correct" listed on a notice is based on the time it should take to correct an issue or communicate with the DRC about correcting the issue. For example, a trash tote can be pulled into the garage in moments which is why it has a 1-day correction period; weeds have a 14-day correction period as that requires time to spray and pull the weeds; but something like re-painting a house requires supplies, a contractor, a submittal for new colors, etc., which is why it has a 30-day correction period. As long as a resident has communicated within the 14- or 30-day period acknowledging receipt of a notice, no additional notices will be sent as long as the resident does correct the issue or continues communicating as work progresses.

Additional notices are generated when the "period to correct" has passed and no communications or obvious efforts have been made to bring about resolution. If a resident reaches out once they have received a Courtesy Notice with an explanation of extenuating circumstances or their plans to correct, we will note the account and grant the time necessary to bring the Lot into compliance. If a resident reaches out about an issue BEFORE they have been notified, that is extremely helpful to the DRC, and we will note your plans and any updates in your account and no notices will be generated regarding the matter.

The DRC is looking to open a channel of communication and educate community members about the Covenants in place for Meridian Ranch. If any resident has questions or concerns or is unsure of what constitutes a "violation," please reach out and we would be happy to talk about it! We are here to answer your questions and help keep the community beautiful while also ensuring the CC&Rs and Design Guidelines are implemented across the community.
