



# Manager's Message

# What's up with the dead trees? Are they being replaced?

Here at the Meridian Service Metro District, we know many residents are concerned about the number of dead trees (nearly 1,000 identified in Meridian Ranch and over 300 removed) and what we're doing about it.

Since the fall of 2022, our Parks & Grounds crew, with some contractor assistance as budget has allowed, began removing the dead trees. Some of the dead trees just did not survive their original planting, but most were severely affected by the rapid cool down and deep freeze brought on by the historic "bomb cyclone" blizzard we experienced in March of 2019. Just as the trees were beginning to bud out, the quick freeze severely damaged many trees, not just in Meridian Ranch, but throughout El Paso and surrounding counties.



We plan to budget for at least 100 trees in 2024, but as you can see, it could take us 10 years or more to fully replace all the trees that currently need attention.



# Meridian Ranch DRC 1 & 2

## Who Does What in Meridian Ranch?

There are multiple entities working in Meridian Ranch to keep the community running as smoothly as possible. They are the Design Review Councils, the Service Districts, and El Paso County.

The Design Review Councils or DRCs are the entities that enforce the covenants by doing governance, approving submittals for landscaping and changes to the properties, as well as hosting community events like the Clean-Up Days, the Holiday Lights Contest, Falcon Freedom Days, etc. Residents pay an annual assessment to the DRC. The Meridian Service Metropolitan District and the Meridian Ranch Metropolitan 2018 Subdistrict are the entities that provides the water, sewer, streetlights, etc. for the community. They are also in charge of the running and maintenance of the Recreational Center, the maintenance of the parks and trails, and the maintenance and landscaping of the common areas. The Service Districts are the entities residents pay monthly and for more information of the services provided and the billing breakdown, please visit their website https://www.meridianservice.org/.

El Paso County is responsible for the maintenance and repairs of the roads, curbs, and sidewalks in Meridian Ranch. The county is also responsible for the snow removal on the streets. Residents are responsible for clearing the sidewalks abutting their Lot. One of the best ways to alert the county to issues with the roads, curbs, and sidewalks is through their website https://citizenconnect.elpasoco.com/#/homepage. You can also sign up for email alerts regarding the issues reported.

### Communications - A Process

When you call or email the DRC, we do our best to respond in a timely manner. With over 3,500 residents currently in the community we cannot always respond to a resident the day they reach out. To make communications more efficient, if you call, please leave ONE voicemail that includes your name, concern, address, and any other pertinent information. If you do not leave a voicemail, we do not know you called. If you email, please email ONE of the email addresses listed below and be sure to include your name, your address, etc. Emails can often be addressed much faster than a phone call, so emailing is recommended. If you have submitted an Improvement plan, we will respond that we have received your plan, let you know if we need additional information, and let you know as soon as we have your approval. Please do not email every few days requesting updates as the necessity to respond to your inquest will only delay all approval responses. When you leave multiple messages AND send multiple emails to multiple different email addresses regarding the same issue, this only causes a delay in our ability to respond.



# RESOLUTION No. MSMD 2023-04

# RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION TO PROPOSITION HH WHICH WILL APPEAR ON THE COLORADO STATEWIDE BALLOT ON NOVEMBER 7, 2023

# SUMMARY OF RESOLUTION

For the reasons set forth below, the Board of Directors concludes that Proposition HH is not in the public interest of the residents of the Meridian Ranch Community as it will diminish the ability of the District to continue to effectively and efficiently provide the level of services and amenities that the public needs, expects, and demands. Therefore, the Board strongly urges a NO vote on Proposition HH at the November 7, 2023 statewide election.

## RECITALS

- 1. The vast majority of local governments, levy a property tax to support essential public services and infrastructure.
- Special districts, including Meridian Service Metropolitan District, are more dependent on property tax revenue than any other type of local government, as it is often their primary, or even sole, source of revenue from which essential and desired infrastructure, amenities and services can be provided.
- 3. Inflation from 2020 to 2023 has increased the cost of labor, materials, and services by nearly 18 percent, but special districts cannot and have not benefitted from increased sales and use tax receipts to offset increased costs of labor, materials, and services.
- 4. Proposition HH will mandate reductions in local property taxes for at least ten years, resulting in billions of dollars of lost revenue for local governments without any corresponding reduction in service obligations.
- 5. Proposition HH will increase the spending limit imposed on the State of Colorado under the Constitutional Amendment known as "TABOR", allowing the State to spend billions of dollars more than it did before instead of having to refund to all tax payers in the State the amount of the tax revenues collected over the limit.
- 6. While Proposition HH increases tax revenue for the State to keep and spend, it places a property tax revenue limit on local governments that is lower than what is allowed or required by TABOR.
- 7. The ballot question for Proposition HH indicates that local governments will be reimbursed from state funds for lost property tax revenue, but those reimbursements are a small
